Event #1 – This event will be a Hybrid course. Although the 2nd venue used the last 2 years was great for a hybrid race, both years we had strong headwind which has led us to look for another 2nd venue.

Event #2 – This year's event is usually our Day 1 event. The local residents love the event. Many of them invite friends over to watch from their front lawn. This course is TS. It will be a little looser than in 2006. The Dovercourt Community center provides washrooms, electricity, 2 staff, shade, playground for kids along with parking and lots of grass to stretch out on. We will have new 3' high start ramps this year.
