- 1. Course:  $100 \times 6'$  cones, no offsets, single lane, timed from C/L of first to C/L of last cone. The course is not exactly straight but gently curves in each direction.
- 2. Equipment: Skateboards only. Helmet required.
- 3. Racing: Each racer gets three runs, single fastest run counts for final placement. 0.1

second added for each cone hit. 11 cones or more hit or any cone missed DQs a run.

This will be the second annual running of this race. There is a perpetual trophy which could be changing hands. It's a wonderful race location and we had some great racing last time, along with everyone having a great time in general.
