Venue description (surface, pitch, length, cone distance, etc). Please describe the hill and course as completely as possible:

The park road we will be using allows a short to medium length course. It is very flat and has has fairly smooth asphalt. Although lightly curved it is relatively fast. Ther is a short uphill runout. The tight slalom course will have approximately 40 cones.

## Venue attractions (local attractions for non-skaters):

The location is a pretty public park in the San Pedro area of Los Angeles. There are stores all around and inexpensive places to stay. The beach and ocean front attractions are a couple of miles away. In the Los Angeles area in general there are numerous diverse and world famous attractions.

### Spectators (expected number, other attractions for spectators, provision for, etc.)

Approximately 30 spectators are anticipated, although the number could go up since it is a public park.

#### The rules are:

- 1. CONES: Seven (7) cones can be hit without DQ. Eight (8) cones hit will result in DQ. Each cone hit will add a 0.1 second penalty to the racer's time. Any cone missed will result in a DQ.
- 2. COURSE: The course is single-lane, push-start with a predetermined maximum and minimum start distance. Timing will occur between the centers of the first and last cones.
- REQUIRED EQUIPMENT: The required equipment for this race is shoes, a skateboard and a
  helmet. Required equipment must be used by all participants for all practice and race runs.
  Other equipment beyond the required equipment will not allowed, with the exception of clothing
  and safety gear.

# **Contest Description:**

This is Harbor Skateboard Racing's fourth race. All of the three previous races have been fun and successful events. Hopefully this race will be equally fun and successful.
