Venue description (surface, pitch, length, etc):

Bike path in public park, 3% slope, good smooth surface, long easy runout.

Venue attractions (local attractions for non-skaters):

The Los Angeles area is a world-class tourist destination. The San Pedro and Harbor area of Los Angeles have parks, restaurants, museums, beaches and many other great amenities for visitors.

Press Coverage:

None anticipated

Competitor amenities (lodging, meals, gifts, etc):

There are many hotels and restaurants nearby. Racers are on their own to acquire meals and lodging.

Race Equipment (ramps, timing, displays, safety gear, etc.):

Chronocone timer (using Pat's signal conversion box which was pried away from Chaput) with tapeswitches. No ramps will be used. There will be a backup Trakmate timer.

1. Helmets are required.

- 2. 13 cones hit will result in a DQ. There will be a 0.1 second cone penalty up to 12 cones.
- 3. The start is an unlimited push from a fixed maximum distance start position. Racers may choose to start closer to the first cone than the fixed maximum distance start position (up to the tape switch position) but not further away. Any foot down after the first cone will result in a DQ.
- 4. The start tape switch will be approximately 5' before the first cone. The end tape switch will be at the last cone.
- 5. This race is for skateboards only. No motors or bindings are allowed. A toe stop is OK if it is not a binding.

Contest Description:

This is an outlaw grassroots tight slalom race, with an emphasis placed on it being a technical course.

Although this is a low-key outlaw slalom race that is primarily attracting racers from the Southern California area, it is open to anyone who wishes to enter. Pre-race signup is not required, in order to encourage people to just show up and race. Despite the casual atmosphere and open entry, this race will feature most (if not all) of the local slalom pros and should result in some serious and very high level slalom competition.
