Dual Hybrid Slalom:

Saturday 6/23 (9AM - 12PM), Golden, CO – Dual Hybrid Slalom. Competitors will each have 2 qualifying runs. After qualifying, all will participate in dual eliminations, A/B Bracketing. Special events for Jrs and Kids, which may be combined, depending on field size. You must choose one and only one class to race in. Same venue as in 2004 and 2005, 50+ cones, newly repaved.

Dual Tight Slalom:

Saturday 6/23 (1PM - 4PM), Golden, CO – Dual Tight Slalom. Competitors will each have 2 qualifying runs. After qualifying, all will participate in dual eliminations, A/B Bracketing. Special events for Jrs and Kids, which may be combined, depending on field size. You must choose one and only one class to race in. Same venue as in 2004 and 2005, 50+ cones, newly repaved.
