Contest Description:

Laid back Grass Roots type of race yet very competitive. Mississippi Grass Roots Slalom and Road Kill Racing try our hardest for everyone to have a good time at an event that is run to the best of our abilities. We have had some hiccups in the past and we've overcome all except Mother Nature.

Race Event #1 description:

On Friday afternoon, beginning at 5:00pm we will be running a slight grade of perfect asphalt with close to 70 or 80 cones set at distances from 6 to 7 foot laid out with straights, offsets, curves and step-overs. We will use the start ramp. Cone penalty will be .1 per cone with a possible max cone limit.

Race Event #2 description:

Luna Slalom Jam will be an open class race, everyone welcome, dual lane, start ramps, four beep start with false start detection, tightish hybrid course but doable by our newer racers. We will be running A, B & C classes. Guaranteed prize purse of \$500. The hill is short but sweet. The surface is near perfect except at the end where surfaces transition to slightly rougher area. It starts off flat then drops fast and steep then levels off to a very slight uphill finish. You'll have to work the pump at the end. This should make for some good racing to the line.

Race Event #3 description:

This is just a bonus. Clifton is building new ramp at his place in the country. We thought it might be fun to have a ramp jam/cookout/bon-fire type gathering after the racing on Saturday night. The ramp is progressing.
