Hog Hill is a purpose-built Council-operated road cycling venue. For Hybrid: Non- cambered 5 degree sloping smooth cycle track road surface, straight, uphill runout. Cone distance 6-7ft. GS spacing 10-15 ft on seven degree similar surface, Curves to left.		
Venue attractions (local attractions for non-skaters):		
On site cafe, changing rooms and showers. Off road cycles can be hired for the dirt circuit. A Freeride with sliding, downhill lite, mini-moto DH and classic luge will be available.

Super G: 7 degree, curves to left. Cone spacing 10-15 ft.
