### **Contest Description:**

### Race Event #1 description:

Tight Slalom will be run as a typical race event with each racer getting (1) qualifying run from each lane on a 50 cone couse, racers will then be seeded into 16 man brackets for dual lane single elimination racing. (If course length allows cone count may be adjusted)

## Race Event #2 description:

Hybrid Slalom will be run as a typical race event with each racer getting (1) qualifying run from each lane on a 50 cone couse, racers will then be seeded into 16 man brackets for dual lane single elimination racing. (If course length allows cone count may be adjusted)

Giant Slalom will be run as a typical race event single lane racing. (If course length allows cone count may be adjusted)
