- Qualification runs will be run with random beep mode.
- GS: The entire event will be using the random beep mode.
- GS: Top 10 (men) will get an additional third run. Best out of three runs count.

All courses will be set on the race day (or prev day) by 3 riders (two French racers + one foreign racer)
