Giant Slalom. Single Lane.

The course is not that fast, but can be very fun with a technical GS. It's wide. BAR style launch ramp to be added this year to add more speed/challenge. 3 runs. .2 cone penalty

Dual Hybrid

Mirrored or parallel depending on hill crown. 2 qualifiers. Top 8, Next 16, the rest. Normal head-head racing, .1 cone penalty.

Tight Slalom. Single Lane.

Parallel tight courses of varying ability. A will be 5'9"-6'5". B will be 6'6"-8'. Any good A beats any good B. 3 runs, fastest run only. .1 cone penalty
